Would you plan for this paper to have additional online resources? Rural Ontario Institute can include relevant links and audio/video content on individual papers if appropriate. Please give details of any initial suggestions for relevant material below.

Word Count

Please give the anticipated length of the final paper, (including notes and bibliography). Please include estimated size of Companion Website resources if any.
