Percent of paid employees with a term or contract job: All census divisions in Ontario vs. non-metro census divisions





Percent of paid employees with an involuntary part-time job: All census divisions vs. non-metro census divisions






Percent of paid employees with a "low wage" job: Finance, insurance and real estate sector





Percent of paid employees with a "low wage" job: All census divisions in Ontario vs. non-metro census divisions




