Our purpose

The Rural Change Makers (RCM) Program helps young adults build confidence and capacity in community changemaking.

Up to 30 individuals (ages 19-35) will have the leadership skills and hands-on experience to benefit their communities, build their preferred futures and become rural community leaders.

Our Impact



Making a difference

78% of Rural Change Makers believed that they made a meaningful contribution to their community by taking part in the program.



Skill Development

93% of Rural Change Makers reported that they were leaving the program with the knowledge and practical skills needed to lead effective community change.



Increased community connectedness

91% believe they can make a difference and have a sense of belonging within their community.



Increased rural retention

72% of Rural Change Makers said they are likely to stay in their local community to work and live. (up from 45% at the start of the program).

The Goal of the RCM program

- **Discover** youth leadership capacity
- **Ignite** impactful rural development outcomes for communities and organizations
- **Engage** in broader rural development initiatives

Program approach:

Young leaders will participate in a series of developmental training sessions, and come together for experiential events in a supportive coaching environment.
