














































































#### The percent of couple families<sup>1</sup> reporting some self-employment income: Sarnia CA<sup>2</sup>






#### The percent of couple families<sup>1</sup> reporting some self-employment income: Orillia CA<sup>2</sup>


## The percent of couple families<sup>1</sup> reporting some self-employment income: Midland CA<sup>2</sup>


#### The percent of couple families<sup>1</sup> reporting some self-employment income: North Bay CA<sup>2</sup>


## The percent of couple families<sup>1</sup> reporting some self-employment income: Elliot Lake CA<sup>2</sup>


# The percent of couple families<sup>1</sup> reporting some self-employment income: Temiskaming Shores CA<sup>2</sup>


## The percent of couple families<sup>1</sup> reporting some self-employment income: Timmins CA<sup>2</sup>


## The percent of couple families<sup>1</sup> reporting some self-employment income: Sault Ste. Marie CA<sup>2</sup>


#### The percent of couple families<sup>1</sup> reporting some self-employment income: Kenora CA<sup>2</sup>
