

Setting the Context: Transportation in Simcoe County





Key characteristics:

- Large geographic area
- Urban/rural diversity
- Significant population growth
- Aging population
- Service delivery challenges
- Transportation options:
 - Public transit (limited)
 - Community-based transportation
 - Private operators
 - Personal vehicle

Community Transportation in Simcoe County



- Community-based service providers
- Fee-for-service or operational funding
- Large geographic area
- Heavy reliance on volunteers





Background: Community Transportation Committee SIMCOL



- The Community Transportation Committee was established in 2012 as part of the Care Connections strategy
- Purpose: Inform and advise on a consistent and coordinated transportation system to improve timely, efficient, & seamless access to health and community services
- Diverse membership
- Key activities:
 - Environmental scan
 - 3-phased community research survey
 - Value Stream Mapping exercise










Value Stream Mapping Exercise





Community Transportation Pilot Grant Program: Project Opportunity



- One-time project funding from the Ministry of Transportation to support local community transportation initiatives
- The MTO's Grant Program recognizes that:
 - Community transportation extends beyond public transit services
 - Many (rural) communities are dependent on community organizations, such as health service or social service agencies, or volunteer organizations, for transportation
- 2-year project: April 1, 2015 to March 31, 2017



Community Transportation Pilot Grant Program: 3 Objectives



Improve mobility options

For individuals without their own transportation including seniors, people with disabilities, students, etc.

Build capacity

To better meet local transportation demand, especially in areas without conventional or specialized transit service due to population size or density

Create networks

Coordinating community transportation service, leveraging existing services, and pooling resources





Coordinated Transportation Models*



Advantages:

- Transportation providers become more knowledgeable with each other
- Opportunities to share experience are identified
- Familiarity and trust develops
- Sets the stage for greater coordination of services (if warranted)
- This model was successfully implemented in Wellington County

The CT Link Project: Community Transportation Link




- Web-based access point for community transportation services providers to share fleet capacity
- Each agency retains client
- Identifies transportation sharing opportunities






Voluntary Cooperation Model



Community Connection 211 provides a point of entry for transportation services for individuals who are not currently associated to a community agency (i.e. "new clients"), information, and referrals



CT Link Utilization



As of November 25, 2016 (~ 5 months)

- Vehicle availability & client ride pickups shared in portal: 137
 - Available vehicle events shared in portal = 96
 - Client In Need of Rides shared = 41
- Current Vehicles Available = 23
- Rides Completed = 14

- Change management








Shows all Shared vehicles








